What to bring to Super Saturday (students & parents/spouses)

- U.S. Department of Education Personal Identification Number (PIN) for you and your parent. **Save time and apply for a PIN in advance at www.pin.ed.gov. You may also get one in real-time when you fill out the online FAFSA.**
- Social Security numbers for you and your parents/spouse
- Driver's license (if available)
- 2012 federal income records, including income tax return and W-2 forms (if 2012 are not available, you can bring most recent)
- 2012 untaxed income records
- Current bank statements, business and investment mortgage information, business and farm records, stock, bond, and other investment records
- Alien registration card (if you are not a U.S. citizen)
