2018 College Scholarship
Application**

The Hanover-Caroline Soil and Water Conservation District’s educational mission is to provide educational opportunities to citizens of Virginia to become good stewards of the environment and natural resources for the benefit of all. Two scholarships of \$5000 each are available to outstanding graduating seniors in Hanover and Caroline County public schools. The District is offering one \$5000 scholarship for a Hanover County public school student and one \$5000 scholarship for a Caroline County public school student.

Criteria for Eligibility

1. Student must attend a Hanover or Caroline public high school AND reside in the respective county.
2. Applied for admission to an accredited institution of post-secondary education, preferably in the state of Virginia.
3. Applicant shall demonstrate an active interest in conservation. Applicant will continue his/her education in a course curriculum related to natural resource conservation, environmental studies and/or agriculture.
4. Applicant shall be in the top 20% of his/her high school graduating class or possess a 3.0 or greater Grade Point Average. The applicant’s most recent official school transcript must accompany the application.
5. Possess good communicative and quantitative skills as indicated by his/her scholastic record and/or personal interview.

Application Procedure

1. In order to be considered for this award, applicants must have applied to and been accepted by a post-secondary institution, not later than May 15, 2018.
2. Applications must be in received in the Hanover-Caroline Soil and Water Conservation District office by close of business on **March 9, 2018**.
