The applicant shall submit a written resume with details of current studies and plans to continue in the automotive industry. This summary need not be greater than 2 pages. It should include institution and studies in which they plan to be enrolled, and their goals for after completion of studies. The summary will be due by April 1, 2019.

The Historic Fredericksburg Region – AACA has established a committee to review and bring forth a recommendation, as well as 2 alternates. These recommendations will be presented, discussed and voted on by the membership at our April meeting. Notification of award to the school and student will be made during the month of May 2019. If possible, I would like to present the scholarship to the recipient during senior awards.

Our outreach for the scholarship will be done with all area high schools and vocational centers, as well as the Skills USA programs of the Fredericksburg region. The Fredericksburg region includes Stafford, Spotsylvania, King George, Caroline and the City of Fredericksburg.

Our Goal is to promote the Historic Fredericksburg Region – AACA's passion to restore, preserve, and display historic cars at local, regional, and national events. In addition, we would like to share with the students the possibility of joining us in our love for historic old cars.

Payment shall be made once the applicant chosen has provided confirmation of acceptance to an appropriate education program as outlined above.
